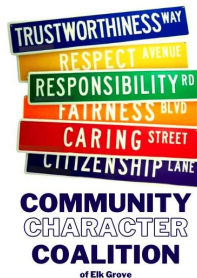


Elk Grove FALLEN SOLDIER Memorial Citizenship Scholarship

Information Page - 2026



Overview:

This scholarship is based on the CHARACTER COUNTS!SM pillar of **Citizenship**. It honors four young citizens of Elk Grove Village who paid the ultimate sacrifice for our nation in the wars that followed the September 11, 2001 attacks on our nation. The four soldiers are:

Phillip E. Frank
John T. Olson
Adriana N. Salem*

The Fallen Soldier Memorial Scholarship is presented by a partnership of the Village of Elk Grove, The Friends of the Elk Grove Library, Shinnyo-en Temple and the Community Character Coalition of Elk Grove.

2026 Awards:

A total of 4 - \$2,000 scholarships will be awarded. Each is a non-renewable scholarship. Scholarships can be awarded for acceptance into 4-year universities, Harper Promise program, and Technical/ Career colleges.

Eligibility:

Applicants must be Elk Grove Village residents and must be beginning their college studies in the Fall Semester 2026.

Requirements:

Applicants must submit a completed application (attached) along with the following:

- ✓ Essay
- ✓ Official High School Transcript

Only complete applications with all required documentation will be considered.

Evaluation Criteria:

In order of importance:

- 1) Service in the community during the four years of your high school experience (accounts for 70% of scoring)
- 2) Citizenship Essay; and (accounts for 20% of scoring)
- 3) Academic achievement (accounts for 10% of scoring)

This is not an academic scholarship, nor is it a need-based scholarship. The primary evaluation criterion is Citizenship. The award committee will look at how applicants understand citizenship and how they have contributed to their school and community by displaying good citizenship.

Selection:

Selection will be made by the Scholarship Committee of the Community Character Coalition of Elk Grove, Friends of the Elk Grove Library and Shinnyo-en Temple.

Deadline:

Application deadline is **5:00 pm on Monday, April 20, 2026**. *Applications received after the deadline will not be considered.* Only complete applications will be accepted. If any section is missing or filled out incorrectly, the entire application will be rejected.
